COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is designed to provide the participant with insights as to the prevention of death and STEMI and methods to reduce disability by promoting early reperfusion of the myocardium involved in STEMI. Emphasized is the importance of a comprehensive and interdisciplinary team approach to the patient with STEMI.

COURSE OBJECTIVES: At the conclusion of this course the participant will be able to:

1. List 3 actions prehospital and ED healthcare providers need to initiate to improve the STEMI Systems of Care.
2. Identify the components of the 12-lead ECG that must be utilized to triage and treat an acute coronary syndrome.
3. Differentiate the three possible categories of STEMI.
4. Identify two pharmacologic agents for discomfort relief and reperfusion in patients with STEMI.
