Stay at Home Order Still in Effect

INYO COUNTY, CA, December 30, 2020 – Inyo County and the Southern region remain under the Stay At Home order issued by the Governor’s office as the available Intensive Care Capacity (ICU) remains at 0%, well below the 15% threshold that triggered the order.

The Regional Stay At Home order will be lifted once the available ICU bed capacity is above 15% at which time Inyo County will return to its designated tier based on case and test positivity rates outlined in the [Blueprint for a Safer Economy](#).

The Stay At Home order continues to restrict recreational travel and many indoor business activities. As our community continues to see rising case numbers and surge activity locally, it is critical that our residents continue to practice measures that reduce the spread of COVID-19: avoid gathering with people outside your household, wear a cloth face covering when entering businesses or interacting with people outside your household, wash your hands and maintain physical distance from others when possible.
